2. What incidents early in the story provide clues about Brille’s personality?

3. How does Brille’s memory of his family give him insight into Warder Hannetje’s character?

4. **Irony** is a contrast between what is expected and what actually exists or occurs. What is ironic about Brille’s eyesight?

5. Did you find the story believable? Why or why not?

6. **Foreshadowing** occurs when a writer provides hints about what will happen in a story. How is Brille's transformation of Warder Hanning into a "good warder" foreshadowed earlier in the story?

7. How does Brille's character compare with your own ideas of a hero? Is Brille heroic? Why or why not?
