# Elements of a Response to Literature Essay Character Analysis

To analyze a character, you examine the following:

- What does the character **do** in the novel?
- What does the character say?
- What do other characters say about him/her?

## Introductory paragraph:

- Hook
- Title of Selection
- Genre
- Brief summary
- Thesis statement-name your character and three predominant traits

## **Body paragraphs**

- Describe one character trait
- Example/quote that supports the character trait
- Explanation about how the example/quote supports the character trait
- Transition words and phrases
- You need at least three character traits/three body paragraphs

## Concluding paragraph

- Restatement of thesis statement
- Summary of main points
- Personal reflection/connection
