### Figurative Language

| <p>Language that contains or uses figures of speech, especially metaphors. Has a different meaning from the <i>literal</i> meaning. Metaphor, personification and hyperbole are a few examples of figurative language</p> | <p><b>Metaphor</b><br/>A comparison between two unlike subjects in which one subject is implied to be another.</p>          |
| <p><b>Hyperbole</b><br/>A ridiculous exaggeration that is not intended to be taken literally.</p>   | <p><b>Personification</b><br/>Attaching human traits and characteristics with inanimate objects, phenomena and animals.</p> |

**Simile**

A comparison between two unlike subjects in which one subject is implied to be another using the words *like* or *as*

**Imagery**

Words and phrases that create “mental images” for the reader. Imagery helps the reader to visualize and therein more realistically experience the author’s writings
