## Literature Questions III - Homework

Read at least two-thirds of the way through your book. Then, answer each of the following questions on a separate sheet of paper with at least four sentences per question. Your responses may be handwritten or typed.

- 1. Name two or three minor characters. Explain how each affected the main character(s).
- 2. What literary techniques can you find in your novel? Flashback? Foreshadowing? Figurative language? Find examples of at least two literary techniques, and explain how they are used in the text.
- 3. How does the author create different moods? Find passages in the text that reveal two different moods, and share. Point out the words, phrases, and actions that helped create the mood in each case.
- 4. How has the story changed your thinking? Or, can you show how it validated or affirmed your thinking?
- 5. Select a passage that you found meaningful. Describe or quote the passage, and explain why you found it meaningful.
