Movie / Music Review II

Congratulations! You have been asked to do another review for *The Good Stuff*. Your first article was so excellent that the editor in chief has demanded to have more of your fine writing. This work assignment is to write a review of a movie or an album of music of your choice. This means, you need to sit down and enjoy a movie (at least 1hr. long) or an album of music (at least 30 min. long) and write a 1-page review for the magazine.

If you reviewed a movie last time, review an album this time. If you reviewed an album last time, review a movie this time. Since your review is going to be a page in a magazine, remember to decorate it!

Important details:

1. The audience of *The Good Stuff* consists mostly of teen readers between the ages of 13 and 18. Make sure you keep the interests of your audience in mind.
2. Your review should be **at least 300 words** in length.
3. Decorate your review with colors and pictures, printed and/or drawn, like a magazine page.
4. Your reviews will be put up on walls or bulletin boards in the classroom/school, so make sure you are doing your best work.
5. Here are some suggestions to get started writing:
 - What is your overall impression of the movie/album?
 - What are the strengths and weaknesses of the movie/album?
 - Describe some key scenes or songs.
 - Give it a rating out of 10 and explain your reasons for your rating.
 - Who would you recommend it to? Why?
