1. Serenity (n) - the state or quality of being calm, or tranquil.
2. Crevasse (n) - a fissure or deep cleft.
3. Pedantic (adj) - overly concerned with minute details, especially in teaching.
4. Terrestrial (adj) - of or relating to the earth or this world.
5. Imperceptible (adj) - not perceived by or affecting the senses.
6. Transfigure (v) - to change in outward form or appearance; transform.
7. Rampart (n) - a fortification or barricade.
8. Iridescence (n) - characterized by lustrous, changing colors.
9. Enigma (n) - a puzzling or inexplicable occurrence or situation.
10. Tantalize (v) - to torment with the sight of something desired but out of reach.
11. Exploit (n) - a striking or notable deed.
12. Ebb (v) - a flowing backward or away; decline or decay.
13. Sentinel (n) - a person or thing that watches or stands as if watching.
14. Emissary (n) - a representative sent on a mission or errand.
15. Irrevocable (adj) - unable to be repealed or annulled; unalterable.
16. Eon (n) - an indefinitely long period of time.
17. Adept (n) - a skilled or proficient person; an expert.
18. Degenerate (adj) - having fallen below a normal or desirable level; deteriorated; degraded.
19. Apparition (n) - something that appears, especially something remarkable or startling.
20. Abyss (n) - a deep, immeasurable space, gulf, or cavity; a vast chasm.
